- Be in 9th - 12th grade
- Hold a leadership role during the operation of the haunt
- Work as a Graveyard Shift Supervisor during the operations phase for Halloween night and **at least 2** other shifts, with duties including:
 1. Daily pre-opening inspections
 2. Cast member assignments
 3. Close down Haunt each night
 4. Manage set problems/repairs
- Develop safety and risk management skills
- Gain goal setting, event management, and vocational skills
- Work hard and earn rewards:
 1. Service hours for most of the time I'm involved (excluding Howl-O-Scream, overnight, or cast party)
 2. Great hands-on leadership experience
 3. Opportunity to attend Howl-O-Scream on September 27th with overnight at Camp Fire afterwards
 4. Free Fright Foreman shirt
 5. Free set of four Buckingham Terror tickets
 6. Invited to Cast Party!
