

# Highlights

•We were awarded \$20,000 from GiveWell Community Foundation for this year's Impact Polk grant. Funds will be used to expand our camping & outdoor recreation programming.

•We were awarded \$2,000 from GiveWell Community Foundation for this year's Empower Polk grant. Funds are allocated for a PA system and a staff retreat.

·Iron Horse Family Foundation granted us \$12,000 towards the purchase of our new van.
